School Routines

As per the roll out of the Welsh Government initiative to provide free lunches to all primary pupils, Years 3 and 4 are now eligible for universal free school meals. Unfortunately, Nursery pupils are not entitled to this free provision. The school lunch menu is available on our website if you wish to discuss options with your child prior to coming to school.

May I also ask that the school is notified in writing of any food allergies your child may have. This is important, not only for any school lunches ordered, but also for any food related activities planned by the class teachers.

A reminder that if your child was previously eligible for free school meals, you must apply for a Free School Meal, even if your child is now eligible for a UPFSM, as this will affect your possible entitlement to a PDG Access Grant.
