Covid Guidelines for September

Please can I appeal to everyone to be vigilant with regards to Covid symptoms. These include:

- **A new continuous cough**
- **A high temperature**
- **Loss of /change to sense of smell/test**

If your child experiences any of these symptoms, however mild, please book a PCR test for them and ensure they isolate until the results are back. If the result is negative, they may return to school. Under 5s are no longer required to take a PCR test unless directed by a doctor. However, they must still self-isolate for 10 days if displaying symptoms.
