As you are aware, until further notice, this is the last day that we will be offering statutory education whilst we are in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic. However, we are determined to support our children and families in the best way we can.

23rd – 27th March

Llantrisant Primary School has been asked to remain open during this week in order to provide emergency childcare for those children who absolutely need to attend. As a country we are being asked to reduce the spread of the COVID-19 virus and we will continue to follow the guidance on self-isolation and social distancing.

Free School Meals

Parents/carers of children who are entitled to free school meals will be able to collect a breakfast and packed lunch from their local primary school during the Coronavirus school closure period.

The food will be a cold provision which will be packaged for take away and can be collected between 11am and midday each day. Each pack will contain a packed lunch for the collection day and breakfast for the following morning.

30th March onwards	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Emergency childcare offered in seven key centres across RCT from 30th March 8am-6pm.• This childcare provision will be for 0-3 year olds and 3-14 year olds.• Once you have completed the online booking form, you will receive notification with regards to which centre your child will be able to attend.

Those who are already in self-isolation must continue to remain in isolation for a period of between 7-14 days and as such will not be able to access any provision until this time has elapsed.
