

# SCHOOL AGREEMENT

## PARENT/CARER AGREEMENT



### I/We will:

- Ensure my child attends school regularly and is in class ready to begin work at 9am each day, properly dressed and equipped, including PE kit and reading books on the required day.
- Provide an explanation if my child is absent in accordance with the school's attendance policy. You must phone/email school before
   9.30am, providing supporting medical evidence whenever possible.
- Support my child's attendance by keeping requests for absence to a minimum and not expect the school to automatically agree any requests for absence, e.g. avoid holiday absence during term time if possible.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour and discipline.
- Support the school's 'Healthy School' ethos.
- Support my child with homework and other opportunities for home learning, especially reading, ensuring that these tasks/reading logs are completed and returned on time.
- Support all staff in their efforts to create a caring community which values children and their rights.
- Make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour.
- Help my child to develop a sense of responsibility, be considerate of others, and support them to make the right choices.
- Attend achievement assemblies, parent workshops and parent meetings to discuss my child's progress.
- Regularly read information on the website and school communication via Parent Mail so that I am kept-up-to-date with important details of relevant policies, meetings, events and information about my child.
- Keep the school informed of any changes in circumstances (i.e. address, phone number, emergency contacts etc.)
