National Testing



This year's National Testing for Years 2-6 will take place between 7th—14th May. It is important that the children attend school during these dates as we are not allowed to submit test scores after this time.

This year there will be changes to the way the Numeracy Test will be taken and it will take the form of an online test. This will provide a more personalised assessment of each child's strengths and area for development in Numeracy. Due to the new testing procedures, this year the report will not provide a standardised score because it is an adaptive test which is personalised to each child. Pupils can take the assessment twice in an academic year and we will be trialling it before Easter in order for the pupils to become more familiar with the procedure. The reading and reasoning tests remain a paper-based test which will provide a standardised score.
