### Coronavirus



As you are aware, we have been and are continuing to follow Public Health Wales guidelines regarding Coronavirus. [Here](#) is a link to a Parent Information Sheet from the local authority with regard to current procedures for schools. This can also be found on our school 'Newsletter' webpage.

Currently, schools are open as normal, however, we need to take a sensible approach in order to ensure that we can minimise the spread of the virus to both staff and children.

Consequently, I will make a decision early next week on whether Parents' Evening will go ahead or whether it will be postponed until things improve.

The Local Authority are continually providing guidance for schools which is issued from Public Health England. The most recent guidance advises schools to:

- Encourage children to wash their hands regularly with soap and water or an alcohol sanitiser. This is especially important after coughing and sneezing and before handling and consuming food.
- Cover a cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the bin.
