Snack

We are a Healthy School so ask that only water is provided for hydration during the day. Milk is provided for pupils from 3-7 years and all children can bring a fruit snack to school. Please ensure that grapes are cut up.

Please note that we are a nut free school and nuts/nut spread should not be sent into school for packed lunches because we have some children with severe allergies to them.

Birthdays

Due to new allergy legislation we do not allow pupils to bring in cakes for their birthday however, we will celebrate your child's birthday in their class.

Lunches

We have recently received confirmation from Welsh Government that from September 2024 pupils attending nursery education on a full-time basis, irrespective how it is funded are eligible to receive universal free school meals.

Attendance

It is so important that your child is in school and on time every day. We open the school gates at 8.50am and shut at 9am. Please note anyone who arrives later to school than this must arrive through the main entrance and their child must be signed in by a responsible adult. Please make every effort to bring your child to school on time. Late arrival is disruptive for the class and your child may miss valuable learning time. Regular lateness can result in a fixed penalty notice fine.

Please keep us informed of the reason for any pupil absence as we still need to closely monitor illness absences and ensure that all pupils are safe and well.

We can authorise up to 10 days holiday but after that any further holiday time is unauthorised. Please complete a holiday request form which is available from the office before going on holiday.
