



Un Llais 2018-19



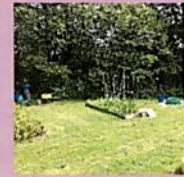
Un Llais have had a very busy year. In September, we set ourselves 4 targets that we have been working towards over the course of the year and here is an overview of our achievements!
